

Pupil progress from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2 2014-2015

Reading:

100% of pupils made expected progress compared to 91% NA. 77% of pupils made more than expected progress compared to 33% NA.

100% of Disadvantaged Pupils made expected progress compared to 92% of Other Pupils nationally. 78% of Disadvantaged Pupils made more than expected progress compared to 34% of Other Pupils nationally.

100% of SEN Pupils made expected progress compared to 83% NA.

Writing:

100% of pupils made expected progress compared to 94% NA. 41% of pupils made more than expected progress compared to 36% NA.

100% of Disadvantaged Pupils made expected progress compared to 95% of Other Pupils nationally. 37% of Disadvantaged Pupils made more than expected progress compared to 37% of Other Pupils nationally.

100% of SEN Pupils made expected progress compared to 88% NA.

Mathematics:

95% of pupils made expected progress compared to 90% NA. 41% of pupils made more than expected progress compared to 34% NA.

94% of Disadvantaged Pupils made expected progress 91% of Other Pupils nationally. 39% of Disadvantaged Pupils made more than expected progress compared to 37% of Other Pupils nationally.

86% of SEN Pupils made expected progress compared to 79% NA

Value Added Progress 2014-2015

This is a way of measuring progress from Year 2 to Year 6. Anything that is above 100, means that children have made at least expected progress. As you can see we are significantly above in reading and maths, and slightly above for writing.

The school has an overall VA score of **101.5** which is significantly above National Averages. This puts us in the 7th Percentile Rank which means that we are in the top seven per cent of schools in the country for Value Added Progress.

In individual subject areas the school is also above 100:

Reading: 101.8 - again significantly above National Averages and the 3rd Percentile Rank, (top 3% of schools in the country).

Writing: 100.7 which puts us in the 25th Percentile Rank, (top 25% of schools in the country).

Mathematics: 101.7 – significantly above National Averages and the 10th Percentile Rank, (top 10% of schools nationally).
