<b>Year 1</b>	Children will be learning greetings, personal questions, colours and numbers 0-15. They will also be revising body parts (from previous year) and reading the story "La Bruja colorines".	Children will be learning classroom instructions, numbers 0-20, animals, colours, and body parts, including the song ♪ "Tengo dos ojos". Children will also learn to use vocabulary linked to Christmas.	Children will be learning numbers 0-30, fruits, animals, and adjectives to describe them. They will learn to answer the question ¿Tienes un animal? and will read the story "Handa's surprise".	Children will be learning to talk about feelings, likes/dislikes (including answering the question ¿Qué animal/color te gusta?), days of the week, colours and numbers 0-30.	Children will be learning numbers 0-50, days of the week, fruits and other food, and the story "La oruga glotona".	Children will be learning numbers 0-50, family, habitats, body parts and the story "El pequeño elefante".
<b>Year 2</b>	Lessons will reinforce what children learned in Year 1. Children will be learning greetings, numbers 0-30, personal questions, colours, countries, body parts and the song ♪ "El juego chirimbolo".	Children will be learning numbers 0-60, days of the week, animals (including the question ¿Tienes un animal?), using negatives and the story "La viejita". Children will also learn to use vocabulary linked to Christmas.	Children will be learning numbers 0-100, days of the week, months of the year, dates including birthdays, and body parts, including the song ♪ "Tengo dos ojos".	Children will be learning numbers 0-100, body parts (including the song ♪ "La tía Mónica"), prepositions and the story "Un cuento muy oscuro".	Children will be learning vocabulary linked to feelings, habitats, animals, the "Gruffalo" story, fruits, actions, likes/dislikes (me gusta/no me gusta) and the story "La sandía gorda".	Children will be learning to talk about healthy eating, sea animals and the sea side. They will also learn the songs ♪ "Un pulpito" and ♪ "Una sardina".
<b>Year 3</b>	Lessons will reinforce what children learned in Year 2. Children will be learning numbers 0-20 using addition and subtraction, days of the week, months, animals and habitats, including adjectives to describe pets. Children will read the story "Lucas y su cerdo" and will write personal info to make ID Cards.	Children will be learning vocabulary linked to numbers 0-60, body parts, and birthdays. They will also learn the song ♪ "Cómo planta usted las flores". Children will also learn to use vocabulary linked to Christmas.	Children will be learning numbers 0-100, telephone numbers, and the sounds "j", "r", "rr" and "c". They will also learn vocabulary linked to family, pets (including adjectives) and colour, and the story "El Ratoncito Pérez".	Children will be learning to write numbers 0-100 and to use +, -, x, ÷, and talk about odd and even numbers. They will learn vocabulary linked to minibeasts, weather and seasons and the story "La Primavera".	Children will learn numbers 0-100, including doubling and halving. They will talk about kitchen objects and sing the song ♪ "Soy una taza". Children will learn further vocabulary relating to animals and fruits, and will read the story "El Secreto".	Children will continue to practise using numbers 0-100, They will talk about sports and will read the story "Anita, la deportista". Children will talk about their likes/dislikes about food including healthy eating preferences.
<b>Year 4</b>	Lessons will reinforce what children learned in Year 3. Children will learn greetings, personal information, and how to introduce themselves and others. They will talk about feelings and emotions, use classroom language, and say and write numbers to 100, Children will also learn to talk about the weather, seasons, countries and dates.	Children will learn the Spanish alphabet, focusing on key sounds in alphabet. They will tell the time on hour, use negative sentences, and learn about animals and their habitats. Children will also learn to use vocabulary linked to Christmas.	Children learn vocabulary linked to farm animals, and learn more about the sounds "c" and "k" in Spanish. Children will use adjectives, including the diminutive "-ito, -ita", and gender -o, -a endings. Children will also learn the songs ♪ "En la granja de mi tío" and ♪ "El pollito pío".	Children will reinforce grammar points from previous term and read the story "Los tres cerditos".	Children will learn vocabulary about school subjects and will talk about likes/dislikes and preferences. They will also tell the time on the hour/half past the hour.	Children will talk about their preferences of colours, describe their families and use numbers to 100. They will use adverbs of intensity, descriptive adjectives, adjectival agreements and speak in the 3rd person. Children will also read and act out the story "El Nabo Gigante".
<b>Year 5</b>	Lessons will reinforce what children learned in Year 4. Children will be learning numbers to 1000, personal information, using the 3 <sup>rd</sup> person, and nationalities including masculine and feminine adjectives to write ID cards/passports. Children will also learn weather expressions and compass directions.	Children will discuss their likes/dislikes, preferences and opinions using connectives, and will revise the Spanish alphabet. Children will also learn to use vocabulary linked to Christmas.	Children will continue to use numbers to 1000. They will describe their families using the possessive article, personal descriptions and descriptive words for hair and eyes.	Children will reinforce their knowledge of numbers and colours. They will learn to talk about clothes and uniform, use Euros and shopping vocabulary. Children will tell the time on hour, half past and quarter past/to the hour, and will read and tell the story "La Cenicienta".	Children will learn about body parts, illness and cures, and telling the time to all points. They will also read the story "El gran monstruo".	Children will learn to talk and write about food and drink, including their preferences. They will learn to read a Spanish menu, use Euros and role play ordering in a restaurant.
<b>Year 6</b>	Lessons will reinforce what children learned in Year 5. Children will use numbers to 1000, say and write personal information, and make passports. They will learn classroom objects, rooms around the house, and use adjectives and connectives.	Children will learn vocabulary linked to home and furniture, and explore differences between England and Spain. Children will also learn to use vocabulary linked to Christmas.	Children will learn about family, home and prepositions, hobbies and free time, and sports (likes/dislikes; juego/ practico). They will discuss their daily routines and give preferences in the 1 <sup>st</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> person.	Children will be learning about clothes, activities to do on holiday, weather and the seasons.	Children will talk about pets and give descriptions. There will also practise reading comprehensions and writing exercises.	Children will talk about and role play eating and drinking, and using Euros. There will also be assessments in speaking, listening, reading and writing.
