English	<p>This term, we will start by reading <i>The Dark</i> by Lemony Snicket. Maths	<p>Our work this term will focus largely on measuring. We will be using scales to find items that are heavy and light, seeing which containers have the most and least capacity and using different items to measure length. We will also learning about the days of the week, months of the year and sequencing our days. Science	<p>This term our science topic will be looking at Habitats and Seasonal Change (Creating and Using Data). We will be hoping to observe changes across the four seasons, observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.</p> <p>Year 1 will be looking to identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other. Children will be identifying and naming a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including microhabitats. Music	<p>This term, children will explore the use of their voices in different ways such as speaking, singing and chanting. They will discover how the voice can produce rhythm and pulse, high and low (pitch) to create different effects. Children will play instruments showing an awareness of others, repeating and investigating simple beats and rhythms. They will investigate making sounds that are very different (loud and quiet, high and low etc.).
