Foundation Stage (Ongoing throughout the year)	<p><b>22-36 months:</b> Pupils will learn that they have similarities and differences that connect them to and distinguish them from others. In pretend play pupils imitate everyday actions and events from own family and cultural background. Pupils enjoy playing with small world models and notice detailed features of objects in heir environment.</p> <p><b>30-50 months:</b> Pupils can talk about significant events in their own experience. Pupils comment and ask questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world Pupils show care and concern for the environment. Pupils can talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects.</p> <p><b>40-60 months:</b> Pupils enjoy joining in with family customs and routines.
