Maths	<p>Our work this term will focus largely on multiplication, division, fractions and measuring. We will be using scales to find items that are heavy and light, seeing which containers have the most and least capacity and using different items to measure length. We will also learning about the days of the week, months of the year and sequencing our days. Science	<p>This term KS1's topic is Animals including humans. We will be learning about animal and humans. We will be identifying and naming a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. ICT/ Computing	<p>Lego Builders</p> <p>Children will learn to compare the effects of adhering strictly to instructions to completing tasks without complete instructions. They will learn to follow and create simple instructions on the computer and consider how the order of instructions affects the result.</p> <p>Maze explorers</p> <p>During this topic we will be learning to understand the functionality of the direction keys and how to create and debug a set of instructions (algorithm). We will learn to use the additional direction keys as part of an algorithm.
