Maths	Our work this term will focus largely on multiplication, division, fractions and measuring. We will be using scales to find items that are heavy and light, seeing which containers have the most and least capacity and using different items to measure length. We will also learning about the days of the week, months of the year and sequencing our days. This will help us a lot when we learn to tell the time by the hour and half past the hour. Learning to describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including pets) and identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
