

Welcome Back!

We are looking forward to welcoming some of you back to school on Monday. When you do come back, you may notice a few changes that have been put in place to keep you and everybody in our school community safe. We would like to share some of these with you so that you know what to look out for on your return. Next week we will all be learning and talking about 'Wellbeing.' If your child displays symptoms of COVID 19, then please DO NOT send them in. If they display them when in school, we will place them in a designated room and we will ask that they are collected.

Staying Safe

When you return, our school rules will remain the same, and we continue to follow 'Good to be Green'. If children do not follow our rules, then parents will be informed. It is extremely important that at this time your children are aware that we all need to be kept safe, including staff and other pupils and we will not accept any behaviour that does not follow our rules or adheres to our COVID Code of Conduct. If your child does not follow the rules, and is putting themselves and others at risk, we may ask for a suitable adult to collect them from school.

COVID Code of Conduct

We have added some extra rules to keep everybody safe.

This is called our **COVID** Code of Conduct. You may already know some of these rules if you have been listening to the news or if you have been out for a walk with your family.

COVID Code of Conduct

- 1. Wash hands regularly and when instructed to by staff.
- 2. Listen carefully to staff and follow all instructions.
- 3. Stay in your bubble and do not wander further than your allotted space.
- 4. Help reduce the spread of germs by carrying a tissue or using tissues provided.
- 5. Use hand sanitizer when instructed
- 6. NEVER cough or spit towards another. (If this occurs then an adult will be called to collect the child)

Arriving in the morning

- 1. Children to arrive at either top or bottom gate depending on which class you are in between 8:45 & 9:15
 - Top Gate by EYFS and Windsor Street (Nursery, Reception, Yr 1 & Yr 2) Bottom Gate by Church and Park Road end (Years 3,4,5 & 6)
 - If you have a child in more than one year group we will allow them in the same gate.
- 2. Parents to stay outside of the school gates and allow staff to escort or

- direct your child. There will be markings on the floor and signs advising maintain 2m social distance.
- 3. Please do not bring anything into school other than a coat if necessary and a sun hat. Please apply sun cream in the morning before school.
- 4. Children will be asked to sanitise their hands before they enter the school building and when they leave.

Uniform

Your child should attend in their school uniform, PE kit or summer uniform. Shoes or trainers are both acceptable during this time. We want your child to feel a sense of normality back in school. However, most importantly they should have clean clothes on each day.

Around the school and in class

Children will remain in bubbles throughout the day and stay with the same staff and children. Lunch times and break times have been carefully worked to ensure that limited mixing between bubbles happens.

Currently our bubbles are for key worker and vulnerable children will be:

Bubble 1 - EYFS, Y1 & Y2

Bubble 2 - Years 3, 4, 5 & 6

These will change as we open the school to more children.

Staying sun safe and hydrated

- 1. Children are allowed to bring a hat to school
- 2. Children will be given a water bottle each day
- 3. Please apply sun cream before school.

Lunchtime and Playtime

- 1. Children will remain in their bubbles and equipment and classrooms will be cleaned when each bubble has finished using either the equipment or in the lunch hall.
- 2. School will provide lunch. We are asking that no lunch bags, bottles, bags etc are brought into school.
- 3. Children will be offered a variety of lunch items and we will to the best of our ability provide them with something that they will eat.

Home time

We ask that you collect your child between 2:45 and 3:15. Please go to the same gate that you dropped your child off at in the morning. Staff will radio for your child and your child will be brought/directed to the gate. On leaving school your child will have sanitized their hands. We ask that you wash your child's uniform each evening and they attend school in a clean uniform each day. This again helps stop the spread of germs.
