



Parents and carers must adhere to the following rules put in place to keep all adults and children as safe as possible and limit the potential for spreading Covid 19.

1. Clothing- Children are to wear clean school uniform daily.
2. Following Government and medical advice, your child will be expected to adhere to social distancing at school and wash their hands frequently, using soap and water to reduce the chances of transmission of the virus. We expect your support and understanding for this.

4. If any member of the household is displaying symptoms of Covid 19, the child is not permitted onto the site and the school must be kept informed of test results, prior to them being allowed back.
5. If a child starts to develop symptoms whilst at school, they must be collected within an hour of notification being received.
6. Results from the test are to be shared with school, whether positive or negative. Until the results have been shared, the child must isolate at home with all members of their household.
7. Parents are to adhere to the social distancing rules laid down by the Government at all times- keep a distance of 2 metres from others not in your household.
8. Drop off and collect your child at the specified time following directions as specified.
9. Staying longer than absolutely necessary; collecting and chatting in groups, is not acceptable.
10. Please remember to treat all members of staff and other parents and children respectfully and leave as soon as you have dropped off or collected your child.
11. On arrival back at home, wash hands with soap and water and wash the clothes the child has been wearing all day.

Your support as we work our way together through this is appreciated as is your co-operation and understanding at this difficult time. If your child breaks the Code of Conduct and puts others in danger, we may ask you to collect them, if it is deemed that they are putting themselves or others in danger.
