Time keeping - School opens between 8:30-9:00. Please ensure that your child does not arrive after 9am. It makes it very difficult for staff to teach classes when children are arriving after 9am. It also requires staff to leave classrooms to escort children around the school ensuring that they get to their bubble without crossing others. Also, it is very important to pick your child up before 3.30pm. The classes need to be thoroughly cleaned, and this cannot start until the children have left for the day.
