COVID Testing – School continues to follow government guidelines. If your child has symptoms (high temperature, a new, continuous cough, and a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste), they must get a PCR test - a lateral flow (quick) test is not enough. If they have these symptoms, everyone in the house must stay at home. We understand that this can be problematic, but we must keep everyone in our school safe. It is our duty of care to ensure that the guidelines are followed. We ask that you are kind to us, as we are really trying hard to keep everyone safe in these strange times.

- Please **wear a face covering and social distance** when dropping off and collecting your child. This keeps us and other families safe
- If any of the children, your family become symptomatic over the weekend or test positive. Please email schoolclosures@st-patricks.liverpool.sch.uk
- If you or child displays COVID-19 symptoms, it is essential that you book a PCR test and inform school ASAP
- These symptoms are a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, and a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste
