<u>Subject</u>	What we will learn	Resources, trips, visitors & ideas of what to do at home
English	The Night Gardener by The Fan Brothers. As well as taking care with our letter size, formation and orientation, we will be working hard to identify new writing tactics for setting descriptions and diary entries. We will be exploring SPAG elements, such as nouns, adjectives, noun phrases, synonyms, commas in a list, conjunctions, prepositions, sentence openers and different types of punctuation. The Bog Baby by Jeanne Willis We will developing our knowledge of narratives by looking at instructions as well as a 'finding' narrative. Our SPAG elements will include verb, adverb, apostrophes, suffixes, exclamations, commands, questions and refining past and present tense.	Ideas for the weekend: visit your local park or botanical gardens. At the end of the weekend, write a diary entry about what you've been up to. Write instructions at home for how to make a sandwich. Trips: n/a
Maths	Numbers Within 100 We will be reading, writing, representing, partitioning and comparing numbers to 100. We will also explore patterns, such as odd and even, tens and ones, etc. Addition and Subtraction of 2-Digit Numbers We will be drawing on our knowledge of number bonds from Year 1 to help us add and subtract 2-digit numbers, e.g. 'If I know 2 and 3 make 5, then I know 20 and 30 make 50'. Addition and Subtraction Word Problems We will be representing and explaining addition and subtracting of 2-digit numbers, as well as creating, labelling and sketching bar models as a way of representing these calculations.	Ideas for the weekend: use cubes or blocks stacked together to represent tens and ones. When going food shopping, try to find number bonds in prices, e.g. 25p - 2+5 is a number bond to? or how many 10s in 25? How many ones? Trips: n/a Resources: dienes sticks, cubes, bead strings, place value charts
<u>Science</u>	Uses of Everyday Materials We will be conducting various experiments to discover the uses of everyday materials and identifying which materials are suitable for a purpose, e.g. which material is best at blocking sunlight? Which material is best for eating off, wood, metal or plastic? etc.	Ideas for the weekend: look at the objects in your house, such as cutlery, curtains, toys and talk about what materials you can spot. Why was this made out that particular material?

	We will be comparing and grouping materials based on whether they are solids, liquids or gases and we will be able to explain why an object can be made from different materials.	
RE	New Beginnings We will be looking at The Creation Story and considering how Christians believe that God is with us during all of our own new beginnings. Signs and Symbols We will be exploring the signs and symbols of Baptism and why this is such a significant part in the life of a Christian. Preparations We will be exploring the preparations for the birth of Christ, such as Advent. Judaism and Islam We will be respectfully exploring and discussing aspects of other religions, such as Judaism in Judaism Week and Islam during Islam Week.	Ideas for the weekend: go to a local park or spot in nature to look out for natural beauty. Go to your local Church or place of Worship.
History/Geography	The Great Fire of London We will be learning about this historic event, comparing 17th Century London to London as we know it today. We will be learning about the events that took place and the significance of Samuel Pepys and his diary. At the Farm In Geography, we will be learning exploring the similarities and differences between arable, dairy and livestock farms. We will also get the opportunity to visit a Croxteth Farm and look at what is involved in these. We will be creating a map of a farm, using keys to identify different points.
