Thank you so much for your support during this difficult time. We have been informed that the Archdiocese are in the process of instructing a structural engineer to carry out a survey to determine the works needed. But, for the time being the other building must remain closed. This poses many different problems such as our resources and instruments being locked in there, extra space including the PE hall etc. Most importantly Y5 & 6 classrooms are no longer in use. Year 5 are working in the hall and Y6 in the ICT suite.
