We will be using scales to find items that are heavy and light, seeing which containers have the most and least capacity and using different items to measure length. We will also learning about the days of the week, months of the year and sequencing our days. This will help us a lot when we learn to tell the time by the hour and half past the hour. We will be looking at calculating with numbers up to 50. Music	In Music this term we will be practising: Rap, sing and play with a sense of pulse and rhythm. Perform songs: 'Hey You!', 'Hands, Feet, Heart' and 'Drive'. Use a glockenspiel and beater correctly, producing a good tone. Learn note names D and E. Follow basic notation. Children will also learn how to appraise their own performance. Following this, children will: Identify different ways sounds can be made and changed. Use and choose sounds confidently in response to a stimulus. Recognise and control how sounds can be made louder, quieter, faster and slower. Choose sounds and instruments and suggest how they should be used and played.
