- 3. Communication on Child's Progress A small percentage of parents feel uninformed.

St. Patrick's Catholic Primary School has a high level of parent satisfaction, with strong academic, behavioural, and extracurricular programs. However, addressing concerns around communication, SEND support, and issue resolution could enhance parent trust and engagement further.
