At St Patrick's, we use **Tapestry** to **celebrate and share the wonderful learning experiences happening across our school**. It provides a secure and positive space for families and staff to share key moments from the children's learning journeys.

How We Use Tapestry

- Staff will upload significant moments and achievements from the classroom and the school day.
- There is no set number of photos or posts for each child; updates will vary depending on what is happening that day, how your child is feeling, and whether they are happy to be photographed or filmed. Not every child always wants to be in the pictures.
- Not every class post will include every child. Some photos or videos may show groups, while
 others will highlight individual achievements.

Communication

- Tapestry is designed for **sharing learning and celebrations**, not for direct communication between families and staff.
- Staff will not respond to individual messages or always reply to comments on pictures.
- If you need to contact a member of staff, please do so through the usual school communication channels (e.g. phone, email, or face-to-face).

Family Contributions

- Families are warmly encouraged to add their own photos or observations from home to share your child's experiences with us.
- These contributions help us build a fuller picture of your child's development and learning journey.

Online Conduct

• We ask that all comments and uploads are respectful and appropriate.

 Any inappropriate or disrespectful content written or shared via Tapestry may result in your access to Tapestry being suspended. Please remember that images and videos from Tapestry must not be shared on social media or outside the platform, to protect the privacy of all children and families.
